### Fiscal Year FY-2010 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Goal

Notice is hereby given that the City of Montgomery and the Montgomery Area Transit System (MATS) have established their proposed (FY) 2010 (2009/2010 calendar year) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program goal for the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) assisted contracting opportunities of 1.2%. In conformance with implementing regulation 49 CFR Parts 23 and 26, as amended, the City of Montgomery and MATS developed the goal based on federal regulations of the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) for DBE participation in MATS and City of Montgomery FTA contract activities for goods and services that MATS or the City needs for the year.

The purpose of this notice is to afford certified DBEs, general contractor groups, minorities, and woman's organizations an opportunity to participate and comment on the draft FY-2010 DBE Goal. The City of Montgomery/MATS DBE program proposed goal and methodology may be reviewed for 45 days starting with the first day of publication of this notice during normal business hours from 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m., Monday-Friday at the City of Montgomery's, Department of Planning and Development, Transportation Planning Division, located at the Intermodal Transportation Facility, 495 Moulton Street, Montgomery, AL 36104.
